Eur., Cetomacrogol before applying Epaderm Cream, Depress pump head Emulsifying Wax BP., (contains Cetostearyl Alcohol and Macrogol Cetostearyl Ether 22], Chlorocresol, Glycerine BP., Purified Water EP.

Storage: Store below 25°C in a dry place. Keep out of the reach of children. Disposal should be handled according to local environmental
